Everyone knows that internet security(安全) is important. The first line of defense(防卫) is a 51 password(密码). But sometimes we get 52 and choose simple ones. Examples 53 “123456”, which topped the list of the worst passwords in 2018.

Splash Data is a security services provider. Every year it publishes(公布) a list of the 54 common and easiest passwords to guess. It analyzes(分析) around 5 million leaked(被泄露的) passwords on the internet 55 the list, *Time* reported.

Passwords on the list include strings(一连串) of simple numbers 56 words, such as “111111” and “sunshine”. Common 57 like “thomas” are also 58 passwords. “Donald”, the first name of US President Donald Trump, 59 made the list this year, coming in at NO. 23.

In order to keep your online activities safe, Splash Data 60 using passwords that have no fewer than 12 mixed characters, as well as creating a unique(独特的) password for each of your online accounts(账户).

American runner Meb Keflezighi thought that he had retired(退役). But he had one more task. At the age of 42, he ran the 2018 Boston Marathon(马拉松) to raise money for the Martin Richard Foundation (MRF). The organization, created by Martin's parents, honors the memory of the eight-year-old boy who was killed in the terrorist(恐怖) attack at the 2013 Boston Marathon.

Born in Eritrea, a country in the Horn of Africa, Keflezighi has had to deal with many difficulties from the time he was growing up. "No running water, no electricity," he said. "You had to go two, three miles to get wood so that you could have fire to cook."

For Keflezighi, running has always been a way of life. "It's what I love to do, and it's who I am," he said. Keflezighi won the 2014 Boston Marathon and the 2009 New York City Marathon, and got a silver medal at the 2004 Summer Games in Athens, Greece.

Keflezighi retired from competition after the 2016 New York City Marathon. But he decided to run one last race. "I'm happy with my achievements," he said. "Now, I'll help others reach their goals."

On the morning of April 16, 2018, Keflezighi set out from the starting line with more than 27,000 other marathoners. They raced through Boston's hilly(多斜坡的) streets, heavy winds and cold rain. "Those were the most difficult conditions I've ever run in," Keflezighi said after the race.

Keflezighi finished in 3 hours and 13 seconds, nearly an hour slower than his winning time at the 2014 Boston Marathon. But this year, Keflezighi was running not for the prize, but for a cause.

"Marathon Meb", as he is called, is still **inspiring** others. He said. "We all have difficult situations, but as long as we can overcome those, there's the finish line waiting for us."

Smartphones, tablets (小平板) and smart watches are banned (禁止) at school for all children under 15 in France. Under the ban students are not able to use their phones at all during school hours, including meal breaks.

“I think it’s a good thing. School is not about being on your phone,” Paris mum Marie-Caroline Madeleine told AFP. “It’s hard with kids. You can’t control what they see and that’s one of the things that worries me as a parent.”

There is no law like this in Australia, but some Australian schools have banned phones.

McKinnon Secondary School in Victoria introduced a total ban in February and Principal Pitsa Binnion said this has been a success.

McKinnon students still have a **Chromebook** to use in every class for day-to-day learning but they’re not allowed to use social media (媒体). Ms. Binnion said at first teachers cheered and students moaned (抱怨), but now they’re seeing the positives (优势). “They come to school and they’re not allowed to use phones at all during the school day, including lunch breaks,” she said.

Ms. Binnion also leads by example and doesn’t use her mobile phone in school. “I think anyone can do it if we’ve done it.”

Not everyone agrees with the bans. Western Sydney University technology researcher Dr. Joanne Orlando wrote in online magazine *The Conversation* earlier this year that Australia should not ban phones in schools because it’s important to educate kids to live in the age they are raised in.

“A good education for students today is knowing how to use technology to learn, communicate and work with ideas,” she wrote. “Banning students from using smartphones is a 1950s response (回答) to a 2018 state-of-play.”

Winter is cold in some places. Many plants do not grow during winter. Some plants die. Snow and ice may cover the ground. It can be hard for animals to find food during winter. Animals get through this time

in many ways.

Birds and butterflies can fly. Many of them do not stick around for the winter. They leave. They go to a place with nice weather. Then they come home in the spring. We call this migration(迁徙). Migrating is a good way to avoid the cold.

Another good way to avoid the cold is to sleep through it. Many animals hide during the winter. Their bodies slow down. They save their energy. They do not eat. They live off their fat. They do this until food returns. We call this hibernation(冬眠). Snakes, frogs and bears hibernate.

Some animals store food in their homes. They do not sleep all winter, but they do much less. They live on what they saved in the summer and fall. This is what squirrels, beavers, and raccoons do. Skunks do this, too.

Other animals tough it out. They do not leave. They do not hide. They must survive(活下来). Sometimes nature helps them out. Some animals grow thicker coats in the winter. Other animals change color. The arctic fox is brown in the summer. His coat turns white in the winter.

Winter may be pretty. It is nice to see snow on the trees. But it is dangerous, too. People are also at risk. You can get frost bitten(冻伤的) or worse. How do you beat the winter? Do you wear a thick coat? Do you stay inside? Or do you live somewhere warm?
