When some teenagers start a new school, they are usually nervous about being part of the group. This was exactly how it was for 15-year-old Sergio Peralta who started his school year.

It was a challenge for Sergio because he was trying to keep his disability a secret to his new classmates. Born with a right hand that was not fully formed, Sergio got used to doing everything with his left hand, including writing. "As I was growing up, many people asked me what was wrong with my hand. So on the first day of school, I really felt like hiding my hand," he said.

But Jeff Wilkins, a teacher in the school's engineering program, learned about the boy's right hand and thought Sergio's classmates could do something. He asked them to think of a way to help. Then they considered building a robotic hand. Leslie Jaramillio, a student, said that the project showed the spirit of the engineering program. "I was introduced to them by the teacher. They ended up telling me that they could build me a prosthetic (假体的) hand, and I never expected it, "said Sergio.

The students decided to deal with the project at once. They chose one online model and worked on it with a printer. To make sure that the end product would actually work, they put the tool to the test with a game of catch. The game was something that Sergio wasn't able to do one-handed. And with the robotic hand, Sergio could catch the ball.

Besides making the robotic hand, the classmates made friends with Sergio and helped him get used to the new school life in ways he never expected. "No one has ever offered me this tool. I'm really lucky to meet them." Sergio said.

Beijing Opera is the most representative of all Chinese traditional dramatic art forms and the largest Chinese opera form. Having a long history, it is developed from absorbing many otherdramatic

forms, mostly from the local drama "Huiban", which was popular in South China during the 18th century. It is a scenic(戏剧的) art **integrating** music, performance, literature, aria(咏叹调), and face painting.

Theatrical art forms in many other countries do not present singing, dancing and spoken parts in one single drama. An opera singer, for example, neither dances nor speaks on stage; there are no singing or dancing parts in a modern



play; in a dance drama, the dancer has no speaking role and does not sing either. Traditional Chinese drama, including Beijing Opera, is a kind of entertainment which includes spoken parts, singing, dancing and acrobatics(杂技).

In addition to its presence in China, Beijing Opera has spread to many other places. Mei Lanfang, one of the most famous performers of all time, was the first to introduce Beijing Opera to foreigners and made highly successful tours to foreign countries.

"You will be puzzled(困惑的) all the way through and a little bored from time to time; but you will be charmed and interested. You will be strongly attracted to Beijing Opera even if you know nothing of the dramatic background." This is how one American traveller described his first experience in watching Beijing Opera.

Beijing Opera is China's national opera and it is full of Chinese cultural traditions. Welcome to China and enjoy Beijing Opera!

Facing a poster of a scary movie, some people can't wait to enjoy it while some quickly close their eyes, hoping for removing the picture from minds. Most of us simply consider that different reactions(反 ) are down to their different characters. Dr. Sherry, from Dalhousie University, says it is the brain which shapes our reactions to fear.

According to Sherry, the brains of the people who love horror movies seem to need a lot more excitement. That's because their excitability (兴奋性) is born to stay low. Thus, their brains are naturally hunting for the chance to deal with that difference in them. That's why some people are willing to pay a lot of money to jump out of an airplane. But not all of these people want to be in real danger. So, they choose to watch scary movies instead. My friend, Peter, an expert in skateboarding, loves watching scary movies as well. "Both horror movies and challenging skateboard movements offer my brain excitement," he says.

"Other people avoid meeting horrors just because their brains usually have a really strong startle response(惊跳反应), so when something scares them, they get hurt badly, no matter on their bodies or spirits." Sherry says. "They are often thought to be more overreaction to unpleasant experience like being scared while watching a horror film." "One of my friends, Miya had to be in hospital for special treatment last week, simply because of catching sight of a scary picture in a horror movie."

But there's also something interesting. Dr. Sherry says that if people keep watching scary movies a lot, they might not be as scared anymore. Our brain can get used to the scary things.

So, in the end, whether we like or dislike scary movies depends on our brains and how they deal with fear and excitement. It's different from one to another, and that's what makes us special when it comes to choosing movies.


