fel Tower and the Grand Canyon. That's 47 amazing.

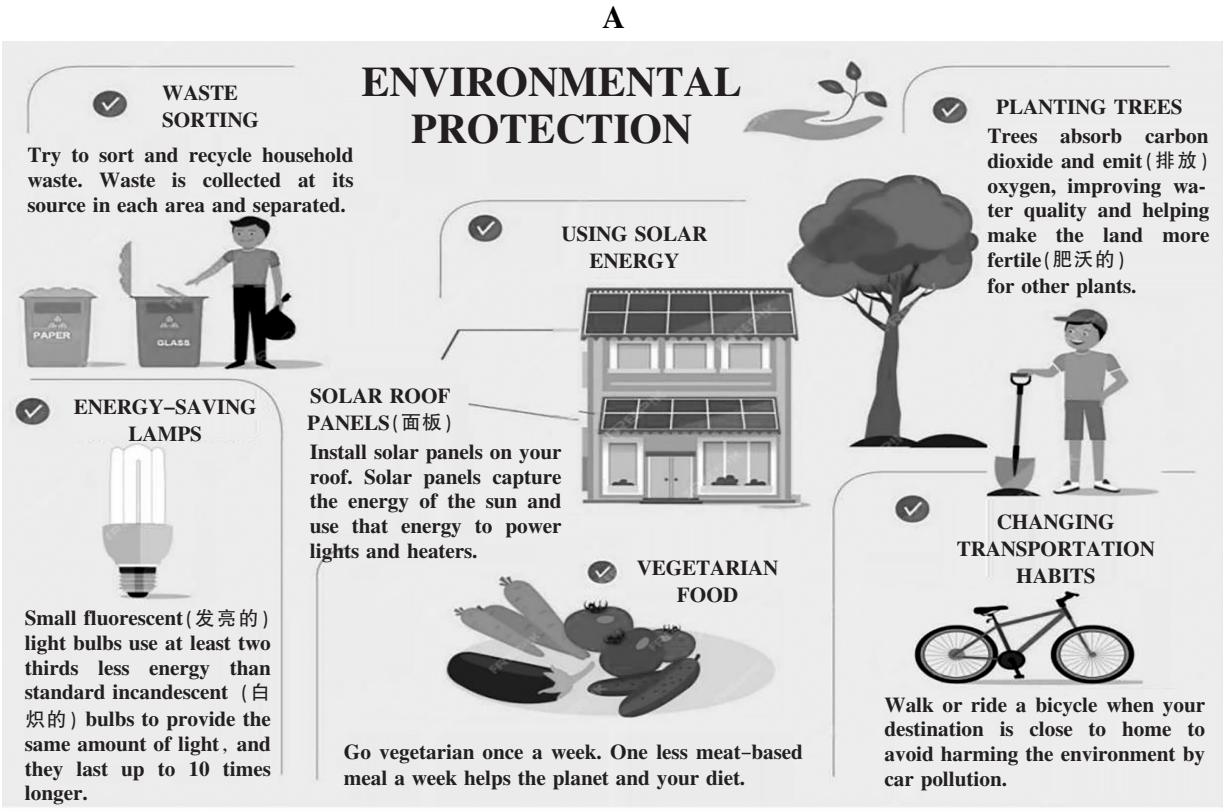
